

Anders Wijkman is an opinionmaker and author who serves in a variety of high-profile positions. He is the Honorary President of the Club of Rome, Chair of the Governing Board of Climate-KIC, and a member of the International Resource Panel.

From 1999 to 2009, Anders was a Member of the European Parliament, during which time he also served as President of GLOBE EU. In 2015-2016 he chaired the Swedish Cross-party Committee on Environmental Objectives, which was responsible for developing Sweden's long-term strategy on Climate Change.

Anders has also held the roles of Assistant Secretary-General of the United Nations, Policy Director of UNDP, Secretary General of the Swedish Red Cross, Secretary General of the Swedish Society for Nature Conservation, and Director General of the Swedish Agency for Research Cooperation with Developing Countries (SAREC).

He is an esteemed member of the Swedish Royal Academy of Sciences, the Swedish Royal Academy of Agriculture and Forestry, the World Future Council, and the World Academy of Arts and Science. To further honor his accomplishments, he was awarded the honorary doctorate from Linköping University in 2011.



Dr Janez Potočnik graduated from the Faculty of Economics at the University of Ljubljana, Slovenia in 1993 with a Ph.D. degree. After beginning his career as a researcher at the Institute of Economic Research in 1989, he was appointed Director of the Institute of Macroeconomic Analysis and Development in 1994.

In 1998, Janez was nominated Head of the Negotiating Team for Accession of Slovenia to the EU and subsequently served as Director of Government Office for European Affairs in 2000 and Minister Councilor at the Office of the Prime Minister in 2001. In 2002, he was

appointed Minister responsible for European Affairs.

In 2004, Janez joined the European Commission and initially served as 'shadow' Commissioner for Enlargement. He then went on to become Commissioner responsible for Science and Research in 2010, followed by Commissioner for Environment in the same year. After the end of his mandate in November 2014, Potočnik was appointed Co-Chair of UN Environment International Resource Panel.

He is a Partner in SYSTEMIQ since April 2016 and a member of the GLOBE EU Advisory Council.
